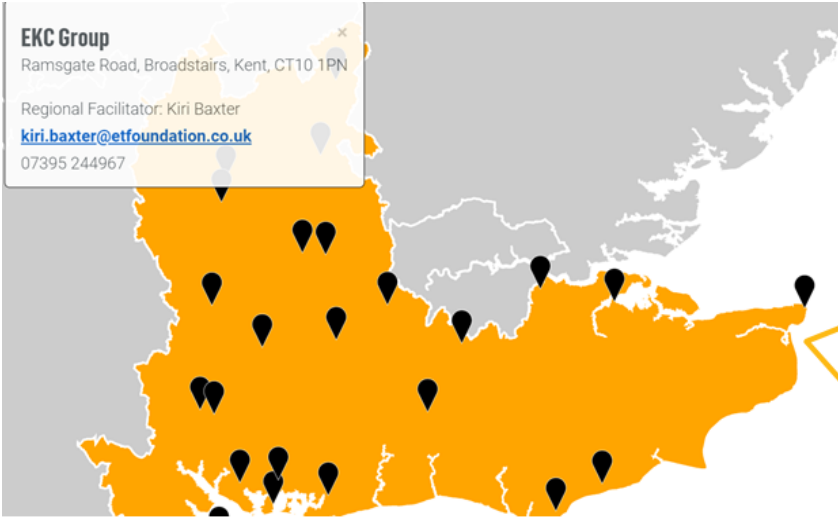

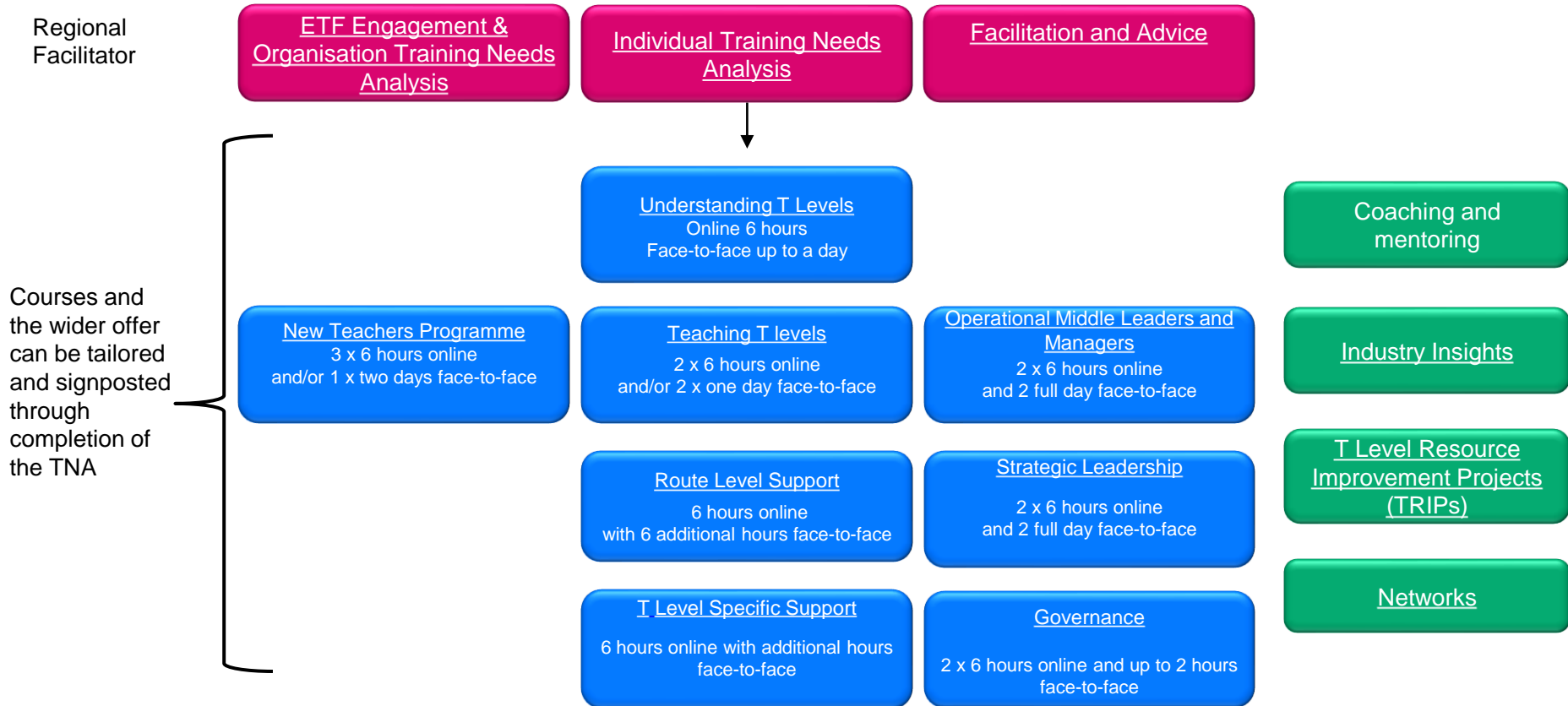

WHAT IS A TRIP

WHAT IS A TRIP

TRIPs are **provider led**, action research projects

Through TRIPs, providers **identify a problem** which would benefit from further investigation and **develop proposals** for **collaborative** project delivery. The size and scale of projects will vary dependent on scope. Each TRIP has a named adviser allocated to **support** them in the delivery of their project.

- TRIPs are suitable for practitioners, managers and specialist provider staff.
- TRIPs will help you to:
 - **identify shared challenges** and priority areas of work to support T Level delivery
 - **develop** teaching practice for T Levels
 - contribute to the **professional development of staff** involved in delivering and supporting T Levels
 - ensure that T Level students **develop the knowledge, skills, behaviours** and occupational competencies required.

T LEVEL RESOURCE IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

- Can be led by any Wave 1 or Wave 2 provider
- Can be small scale – up to £5000 or large – up to £45000
- Intended to enable practitioners, managers and specialist provider staff to develop their teaching practice for T Levels, produce resources, address a specific issue with delivery, contribute to the CPD of staff delivering T Levels.



TRIPS - APPLICATIONS

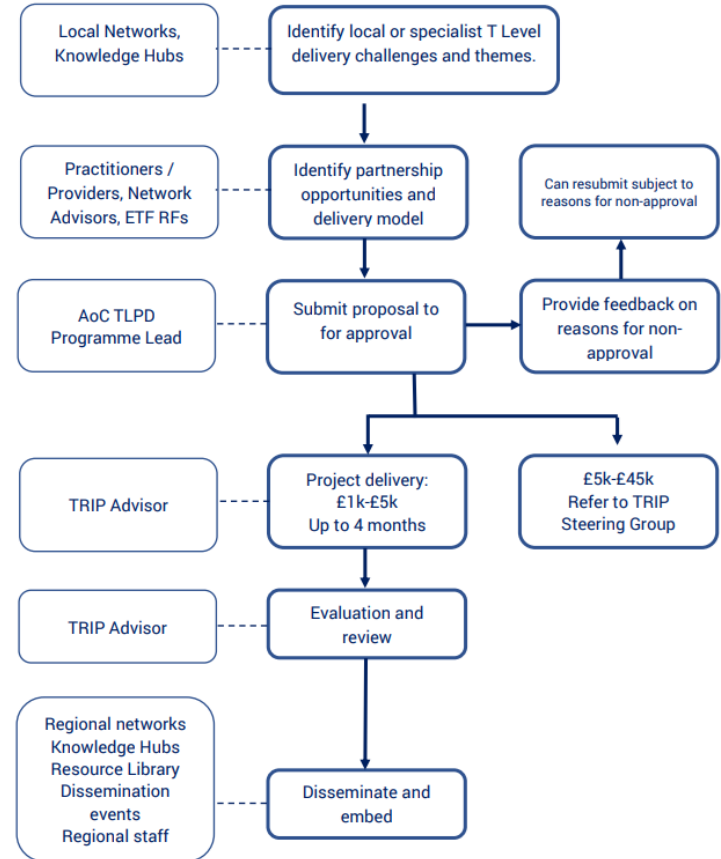
- Applications opened on 1st September
- Downloadable application form and guidance documents on ETF website
- Applicants receive an acknowledgement email, will be reviewed within 1 month
- If unsuccessful, feedback will be given and can providers can reapply.

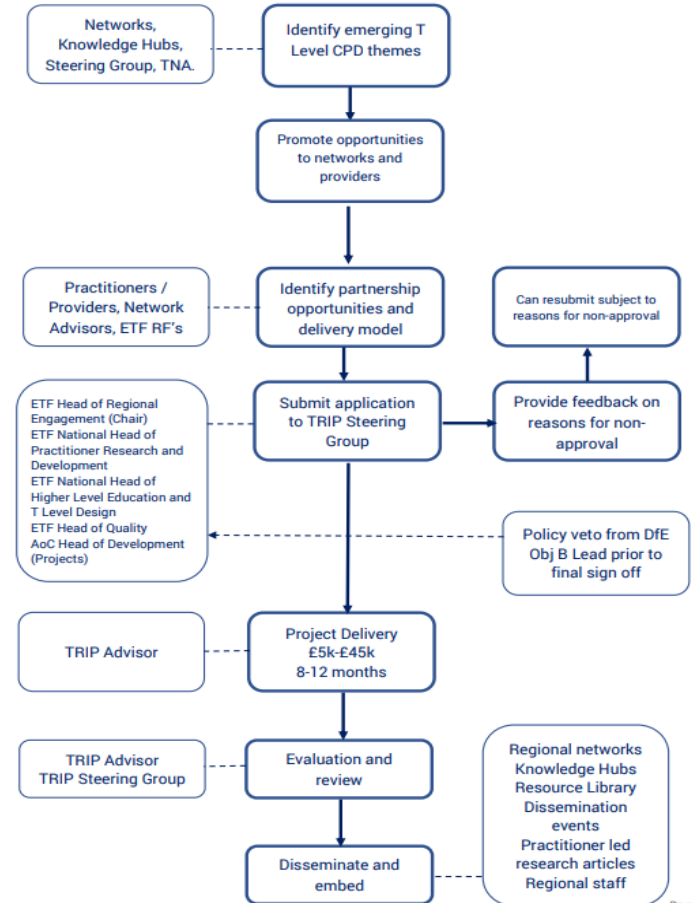
SMALL TRIP PROCESS

- Objectives must be aligned to **developing or improving** T Level delivery
- A **Wave 1 or 2 T Level** provider as the lead member / sponsor responsible for accounting and project delivery and a named lead person for each TRIP
- A minimum of **2 stakeholder organisations** (including the TRIP lead provider)
- Detailed project plan including how the money will be spent.
- Only ESFA organisations can receive money for staff costs or management fees.



LARGE TRIP PROCESS

- Objectives must be aligned to **developing or improving** T Level delivery
- A **Wave 1 or 2 T Level provider** as the lead member / sponsor responsible for accounting and project delivery and a named lead person for each TRIP
- A minimum of **4 stakeholder organisations** (including the TRIP lead provider)
- Detailed project plan including how the money will be spent.
- Only ESFA organisations can receive money for staff costs or management fees.



OUTCOMES, EVALUATION AND DISSEMINATION



- Supported by the AOC
- Feedback from large TRIPs will be fed back to National Knowledge Hub for dissemination
- Outcomes will inform further development of TLPD CPD
- Outcomes and resources will be on the website
- Practitioners will share resources and findings via blogs and ETF news articles
- Lead practitioner from each TRIP will be expected to attend local and national dissemination events

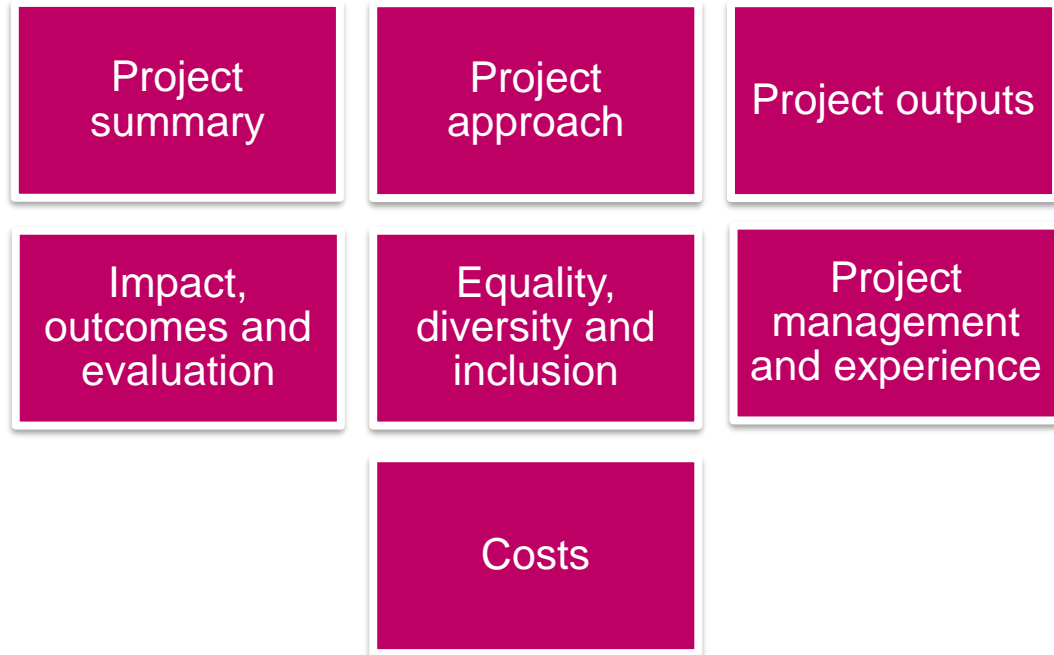
EXAMPLES OF PREVIOUS TRIPS

- Supporting SEND students in placements
- Gaps in skill set relating to T Level delivery (staff)
- Formative assessment in the Education and childcare
- Co-constructing curriculum design for T Levels
- Marketing of T Levels
- Assessing Industry Placements
- Anticipating Inclusion Needs for SEND students in T Level Delivery
- Developing in students the knowledge, skills and behaviours expected by employers hosting T Level industry placements
- Embedding English and maths on placement
- Exploring Innovative Healthcare and Healthcare Science Placement Pathways

ASSESSMENT PANEL DECISIONS

Key areas of the application:

- Project summary
- Project approach
- Project outputs
- Impact, outcomes and evaluation
- ED&I- how are you advancing it?
- Project management and experience?
- Costs- is it good value for money?

Assessment

- Tracking progress using formative assessment (assessment for learning)
- Preparation for examination experiences

Pedagogy

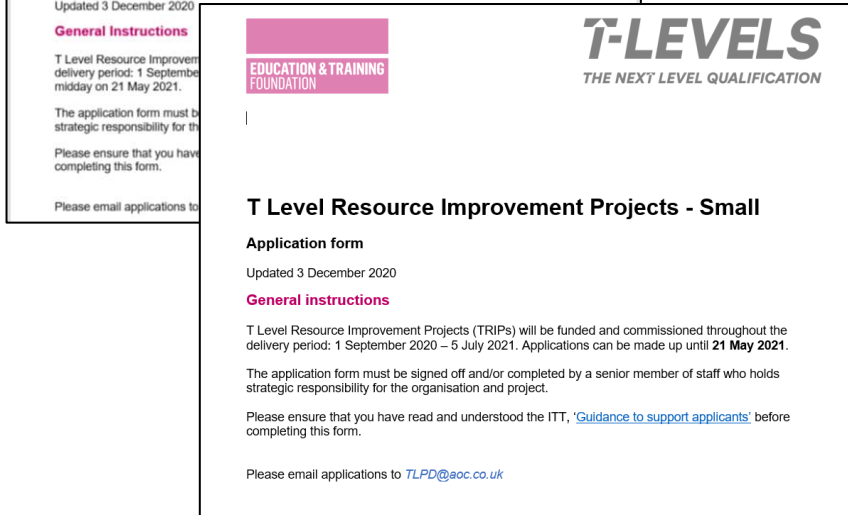
- How will the learning experience be positive and engaging?
- How are behaviours, values, wellbeing developed? (Role of teaching vs learning)
