Remo is an exciting virtual conference hall enabling delegates to arrive and be seated with delegates, colleagues, or in KFE4Skills' case with other students or staff from home or other colleges. Combined with using this programme, it is an ideal way to choose which parts of the day you wish to watch (or participate in) and sit back and enjoy the series of showcases being presented.

Once you arrive in the virtual conference hall, you will be on one of 4 floors. To get more out of the day and the Remo platform, it is possible for delegates to have direct video conversations with others at their table (rather like Zoom, Google Meet or Teams) or even move tables to speak to other delegates for networking purposes.

You will also see useful options to look up others at the event, direct message and submit questions during the day. The core showcase presentations and videos will suspend the table conversation function, whilst allowing communication with via the messaging and Q&A functions during the day.
