Note that in terms of the showcase each performance must not exceed 4 minutes.

3	Showcase Task Brief Description	To be completed by lead brief writer: This section should describe in uncomplicated terms what the students are to prepare or demonstrate and how or in what way. It should provide the total time required for the task in addition to the time that the showcasing element may take. For example, the pre-event preparation for creating a digital video may take several hours but the showcase product might be 2 minutes in duration. Tasks ideally should be singular in nature and not multiple tasks.	Complete showcase brief (detail the task or challenge): This showcase task is for the students is to be: Create and undertake a performance from one of the category options. Performances must be no longer than 4 minutes. Whilst the tutors may support work, work should be encouraged to be predominantly student's(s') work. Please note performances from published plays, musicals as well as the student's(s') own devised work are all suitable. Any permissions or licences required to perform such content should be acquired and responsibility for this rests with the student's(s') home college. The choice of material for each sub-industry category is to be decided by each college. The material must be suitable for a 16+ audience (common sense should be applied to the appropriateness of content). *The task's performance style/content is completely flexible and can include work that might be part of students' main programme of study activities, portfolio submissions and assessed activities taking place this year. There are no prescribed themes. It is up to the colleges and participating students to define how they wish to complete and showcase the tasks — but for performing arts it will be expected to be a pre-
			recorded performance. There is not an expectation to perform live on the event day. The showcase material can be produced in advance of the event and this content will need to be provided to KFE by noon 11 June 2021. The event is 18 June 2021 via Remo.

5	Showcase / Demo Duration	This is the time that the actual showcase or demonstration activity will take per student or team – for example 2 or 5 minutes. The total showcase time for the industry skill should also be indicated – for example 15 minutes if 3 students undertook a 5 minute demo.	 Confirm the expected time required for individual students (teams) to: Performances are expected to have a showcase time of up to 12 minutes per college in total. This means each college should aim to produce a showcase of up to 12 minutes in terms of maximum performance time across all three categories combined. Prepare for the showcase task: This is flexible and is at the discretion of the students and each college's industry lead but should reflect the task level and duration. Tech time for Performing Arts showcases will need to be considered, but there is no time limit on preparational activity or rehearsals. Duration of the finished task for the purposes of the showcase: There will be up to 12 minutes per college based on 2 college organisations for performances. This will remain the same to if 3 college organisations participate. Total time required for the whole showcase transmission on Remo: 30-45 minutes for showcase transmission on Remo subject to above. Performing Arts showcases may be repeated during the day depending on the schedule.



			 The showcase may also include 3-5 minutes of overview or summary content from industry lead staff which may include speaking to the students as a panel about their work and experiences at college undertaking the subject or indeed their next steps. This would be via Remo which can facilitate several presenters in discussion similarly to a conference panel. Confident students will need to be included and a scripted set of questions and responses is recommended. Finished pre-recorded or prepared contents for the showcases will need to be provided to KFE by: 11 June 2021

It may be that some students help with performance tech support, creating the showcase contents for example or creating video or photographs of the tasks being undertaken as they are produced. All student participants will receive a KFE4Skills participation medal. What roles will they primarily assist with: Presentation content help. Production. How many will be required per student / college organisation: As required. These should also be registered on the KFE4Skills portal as they may wish to watch the showcase live and be in the Remo audience.
